While it does not eliminate personal interviews & searching books, maps, original documents, etc, the advent of the Internet provides an enormous resource that can help locate ancestors, as well as individuals and entire branches of our family clans who are not aware of the existence of the others. The following list constitutes a large number of investigatory possibilities that are, frankly, many more than any one person can handle. The intention is that this serve as a master list for the entire family to use so that searches and research is not duplicated. As new leads or "hits" are found, they should be reported to the webmaster of the family website so that they can be added. Subsequently, any leads that have "panned out" should be reported so that they can be removed or noted here. Thus, most of the following should be investigated further. When a particular person is doing research work, that has also been noted so that others may either collaborate with them, or know not to duplicate research someone else is pursuing.

NOTE: ALL other family researchers searching for Chalef(f)s, Directors, Direktovich's, Gilners, Olembergs & Olenbergs, on JEWISH-GEN, have been contacted and invited to share information. Some possible related family branches may have already been located, but documentation as to where they "connect" to us is being sought. As documented relations are found, they will be disclosed to the family.

Michele Olenberg Hollander has been in contact with some "Olenbergs" she found on "Facebook". Some have turned out not to be related, but some may prove to be upon further research. See notes in an email from her further on herein.

These "social networking" contact sites (Facebook, MySpace, MyPlace, etc) are a tremendous resource for locating other branches or our various family "clans" and should be utilized to search for all of our family names and expand our family tree. Be sure to learn about SOUNDEX which can let you know about variations in the spelling of family surnames which, from a genealogy standpoint, are considered to be trivial.

According to the foremost expert on Polish-Jewish surnames...and in contrast to some of the family's opinion of the names' origin...Olemberg/Olenberg derived, originally, from Ailenberg/Ajlemberg/Ajlenberg and the people themselves appear to have originated in Oldenberg, Lower Saxony, from the 1570's, and related to a famous rabbi from that time...his specific name not known, but available from Stanley Diamond, of JRI-Poland. Note that surnames were not required in Russia until after 1820-something, and it is known that the Dutch were unwilling to give up the patronymic names (like the Jews) until forced to do so around the same time.

Interestingly, note that the survey of surnames in the Csestochowa-Radamsko area showed a number of Ajlenbergs and Ailenbergs and one Olenberg. The supposition is that Olenbergs might have been in that area before going to Lithuania and then, from cholera and famine, forced south to the Wyszkow area. It is also possible that some Lithuanian refugees went much further south toward the area that became Turkey or to what was is now Belarus (Minsk, Pinsk etc), or even further south in Russia, but no suspected Olenberg/Olemberg ancestor's records have been located there yet.

Mark & Karl can probably be disregarded as relatives, based or origin and name. But Baszie (Bessie?), Ratha, Salomon and Stanislaw should be followed up on. It is unknown whether Ratha or Stanislaw would ever be used as a Jew's given name, but probably shouldn't be discounted "out of hand".

Warschau is obviously Warsaw, which is less than 40 miles from Wyszkow. Rachmistrowka may refer to a shtetl near Tarnovka, Ukraine, which was something like 300 miles southeast of Wyszkow.

Hi Olen,

Attached is a family tree on the GILNER side. I was attempting to go back to the Polish records, but I don't remember how to go further. At one time, I was able to find out that my great-grandparents, Anna GILNER and Harry MALINA had a child who must have died early or at birth, but no one in my family was aware of it. I don't know where I got that information! I would love to locate records of my great-grandparents births and their parents, etc. I did find their marriage records on the Jewish Records Indexing. Also, I don't have the Yiddish names for some, so I am unable to match them up.

I sent away to the cemetery where my grandmother is, Beth David in New York, and they gave me some information on other burials near her grave. One was for Harry GILNER who was married to Ida (she is also buried there), another is for Murray GILNER whose wife was Anna, and Arnold GILNER whose wife was Carolyn GILNER. Do any of these names mean anything to you? Their dates of death are between 1965 and 1994. I believe Harry was my grandmother's brother, and that he was a rabbi, but I don't know about the others.

Did your name come from OLENBERG? Have you been in contact with anyone else who is a GILNER? Quite a while ago, I was in touch with a distant cousin who found me through JewishGen and lives in CA. He sent me his tree, and we found where the link was. I started researching genealogy in 1993 after my mother passed away. Now I dab at it when some new info comes up. I am pretty much at a standstill.

It is quite possible that we are related. Hannah GILNER (born July 22, 1920 in NY) was a first cousin to my mother. She had a sister named KITTY. I met both of them, but they are all gone now. They lived in NY, but all moved to FL at some point, and that is where I met them. It is my understanding that they also originated from Wyszkow, Poland. All of my info is on the Family Tree Maker Program, but somehow I lost the part about this section of our family.

My grandparents were first cousins; their parents were brother & sister. My grandparent's names were: David MALINA and Kate GILNER. David's parents were: Anna (Chana Ruchla) GILNER (born abt. 1873) and Harry MALINA. I haven't gone back further to find out who Anna's parents were. Kate's parents were Aaron Jacob GILNER (born abt. 1860's) and Ester Bialestotsky AUERBACH. If you like, I can try to forward a copy of our family tree to you.

Hi Olen,

The Wyszkov connection is encouraging. You asked how I knew that Chaja Olemberg died in childbirth. Ashkenazy Jews don't name children after living ancestors, such as parents. That Chaja Dinah had the same first name is a good indication that Chaja died in childbirth, plus the second name "Dinah" comes from the Hebrew word Din, which connotes God's judgement, and as a name is often associated with the premature death of a loved one. Please keep me informed if you are able to obtain any olenberg records for Wyszkow. I'll check out the website and let you know if I discover anything new in my own research.

She found out that her great-grandparents names were Isadore and Ida Olenberg. Their children were Herbert and Albert. Herbert was her grandfather (children: Iris and Lee Olenberg). Lee is her father who had her and her sister and brother. Iris has 2 kids, Brittany and Matt. Albert Olenberg had a daughter named Ina Levitsky and they have a daughter named Beth.

Now the question remains... Where was Isadore Olenberg from and who was he to us???? Since he was Carli's great-grandfather and Carli is exactly my oldest son's age, I'm gong to guess that Isadore was around the same age as my grandfather, Bernard (going with the assumption that each generation had children around the same time). This would make me think that they could have been first cousins, perhaps???? This is one big hypothesis, of course, considering that we know that there was a big age disparity between the brothers (Bernard, Frank, Simha, etc.) which was not uncommon in those days when families were so large. Any theories??? Carli is trying to find out more.

I've also been in touch with 3 other Olenbergs...

Luisa Olenberg's family moved from Kazachastan to Germany in 1992. So far, that's all she knows.

Alyssa Olenberg, from California, is definitely Jewish and wrote that her mother had mentioned once that the family was from Kiev. He mother also had a theory that the name Olenberg had been changed at Eliis Island from Oldenberg to Olenberg. She's trying to get more info.

Email from Harry Olenberg, Sept. 11, 2008:

Yit(z)hak Yankel Olenberg was the first cousin of my father Bernard and, of course, of Simcha and Frank. He showed up at our house after the war (best recollection, the late 1940s) and it turned out that he had spent the war years in a hole in the ground fed by a Polish farmer. He married, changed his name to Olen, and had at least one child, a son who was a teacher, and may still be one, at Truman H.S. in the educational park at Co-Op city in the Bronx. A friend of mine was a school secretary there at the time, and noticing the similarity of names, put him in contact with me. I spoke to Yithak Yankel briefly on the phone but we never developed anything beyond that. I am sure that if you contact Truman H.S. they will be able to tell you how to contact the son.

As far as a picture of my Grandmother Sara is concerned I just may have one. If I do my wife Marlene will know where it is and I will contact you to let you know what is what.

List of victims from Yizkor books

Research using spelling OHLENBERG or OHLEMBERG brings up numerous obviously German persons. HOWEVER, there is one very promising hit from Ellis Island:

Ester Ohlenberg, arrived July 6, 1902 on the Moltke from Hamburg, having originated in Wiszkov. She was 18, single, a "laborer" and had \$1 in her pocket. It appears she was traveling alone and her destination was her brother David Ohlenberg in Rochester, NY. The rarity of the surname and the small size of Wyszkow would tend to indicate a probable connection to the family. (Age would indicate she was a sister cousin or niece of Mordechai Mendel)

Note that there appear to be only 4 places in the US where Jewish Olenberg/Olemberg, etc, families originally arrived &/or settled: Buffalo & NYC, NY, Philadelphia area, PA, and Miami Florida. It should be investigated to determine whether Ester &/or David were the progenitors of the Buffalo family. Research should be done to determine whether Ester and David were brothers of Abraham Icek Olenberg and children of Mozek Ber Olenberg.

Another search of "similar spellings" from Ellis Island brought up one other interesting name: Izak Oelenberg, an "Austrian Hebrew" who arrived July 28, 1903 from Rotterdam, Holland on the Potsdam, originally from Kudryncy, Austria. He was 30, male, single, a tailor, carrying \$5 and going to stay with a cousin M(s?) Gruber at 144 Orchard St, NY, NY.

A Salomon Olenberg had arrived August 29, 1901 from the (same?) Austrian town of Kudrynce aboard the Graf Waldersee out of Hamburg. 26, male, single, he was got to his brother _____, 163 Suffolk St (NY?). Occupation was not clear...possibly an egg merchant???

Contains this interesting information, though this is not necessarily for a Jewish person/family: ULENBERG: Early pioneers. On Nov. 5, 1874, Piotr, son of Ludwik Ulenberg (in source Ulmberg) and Maria née Nakielska, married Anna Stopiñska at St. Stanislaus Church. Piotr died Dec. 18, 1876 at the recorded age of 26 years, 8 months. Fr. Pitass recorded his place of birth as Grabowo in the powiat ("district") of Koœcierzyna near Gdañsk. The Erie County Alien Declarations Index lists Joseph Ulenberg (in source Ullenbarg) in 1874. Joseph (1842-1921) is buried at St. John the Baptist Cemetery, Boston, NY. Derived from the Low German Ulen, "owls" + Berg, "mountain" (e.g., Sowia Góra north of Miêdzychód was known as German Eulenberg). The West Prussian Land Register 1772/73 (this area is now northcentral Poland) lists Olenberg, Uhlenberg, Ulenberg and Ullenberg. 443 people surnamed Ulenberg in Poland along with 175 Uhlenberg, 1 Uhleburg, 1 Uhleburg and 1 Uleberg.
